- 3. Attorneys Kruck and Campbell will be increasing hourly rates for legal services for 2026 to \$250.00/hr.
- 4. The Association of Towns, dues for 2026 to be \$1,000.00.
- 5. Unifirst has increased cost of uniforms for the Highway Department as of August 2025.
- 6. Park cameras are in and functioning.
- 7. Bees this year required Exterminator services at both the Park and Townhall.

Old Business

1. Motion allowing the Town Supervisor to sign the EFC Engineering agreement and the Architect and Engineering Certification form and return to the Water Sewer Authority.

2. The Sewer Debt Tax amount at Livingston County went from \$90,000 to \$98,000. This will include an additional \$10/per qtr. debt levy.

<u>Motion</u> made by Deputy Supervisor Gnau, to do away with the \$10.00 that's on the recorded debt levy for the sewer and add it to the sewer debt tax, and raise the sewer debt tax amount from \$90,000 to \$98,500 per year with the property tax bill, seconded by Councilmember Canute Jr.; Roll Call: Councilmember Canute Jr., Aye, Councilmember Proctor, aye; Deputy Supervisor Gnau, aye; Supervisor Babbitt Henry, aye; motion carried.

3. Discussion with Board members on the Highway pickup truck reaching 50k miles; Highway Superintendent, is to start pricing new pickup trucks, Highway superintendent is to look into Auction International for auctioning off the current Highway pickup truck; the Highway pickup truck is to get detailed before sending to auction.

New Business

- 1. Board Members discussed Springwater Fire Chief Brian Nadeau's failure to comply with NYS Fire Code Regulations section 112 NYS Fire Code Regulations section 112, Board Members agreed an informational letter should be sent to the Fire Commissioner.
- 2. The Springwater Town Code Officer proposed rate increases for the building Department Fee Schedule.

3. Resolution #38 of 2025 Requesting state assistance for a reassessment project for the Town of Springwater.

The Town of Springwater has undergone the revaluation of real properties within the Town; the Town feels that it is necessary to conduct a reassessment project of all properties for the 2026 assessment roll to maintain a uniform standard of assessment for the Town. The Town of Springwater request state assistance, specifically from the NYS Office of Real Property Services, to do a reassessment project to maintain a uniform standard of assessment in accordance with Section 305 of the Real Property Tax Law.

4. Water Debt Tax \$10 per quarter; \$40.00/per yr; Water Sewer Authority will not collect in 2026.

Councilman Gnau (Highway, LCWSA) - Councilmember Gnau shared he has received several phone calls on fixing the fill station; Town to get quotes from Livingston County for cost of meter in pit and cost of band go from there.
